THE QUEEN'S NINE | THE KING'S NINE

The Royal Club has set forth the following requirements on the use and purchase of personal golf cars at the Royal Golf Club and the surrounding housing community.

Requirements for Personal/Private Golf Car Ownership/Use:

1. Electric Powered Golf Cars Only.
 - a. This allows us to maintain the quality of noise, emissions, and speed standard set for the fleet being run at the Royal Golf Club.
 - b. Reasonable speeds must be maintained at all times being respectful to others using the paths accessing the clubhouse. Keep right.
 - c. Cars/Carts must stay on paved paths at all times. No driving on any grass anytime other than when you have a scheduled tee time to play golf.
 - d. Golf cart are not allowed on the short course at any time unless cleared by the clubhouse.
2. Model year must not date back more than 6 years and must be kept in good repair at all times. (Example: Golf car purchased in 2018 cannot be older than a 2013)
 - a. This prevents older more worn looking vehicles from being driven on the course and maintains the image of the course and the neighborhood.
3. No color that matches the RGC golf cars (example: No Ivory/White Cars), No color restriction otherwise as long as it is not offensive. This is done to distinguish the Royal Golf Club fleet vs private owners. If you're not sure please contact the clubhouse prior to purchasing your car.
4. No Aggressive/Off Road Tires, (street/golf/turf only)
5. Minimum Mandatory Accessories:
 - a. Headlight/ Taillight
 - b. Rearview Mirror
 - c. Sun Top/Roof
 - d. Windshield
 - e. Sand and seed bottle if cart is used for golfing.
6. Additional Accessories Allowed, but not limited to:
 - a. Custom Seats
 - b. Custom Wheels
 - c. Golf Attachment & Accessories
 - d. If it's an unusual accessory please ask the clubhouse prior to purchase.
7. Royal Golf Club will provide an annual permit sticker when an annual cart pass has been purchased. The sticker must be placed on the lower left-hand side of the windshield and will be tied to the golf cart owner.

This allows RGC to make sure a trail fee has been collected and that the car being used on the course has been approved. All carts may be subjected to an annual inspection.
8. Failure to meet all requirements of this agreement may lead to your permit being revoked by RGC at their sole discretion.
9. These requirements are subject to change or modification.
